Introduced EV 3-ton trucks for convenience store deliveries. Began operation at Shinko Branch in early August.

Minaminihon Total Logistics Service Inc. (CEO: Keiichiro Ozono, Head Office: Nakano-ku, Tokyo) has introduced BEV (Battery Electric Vehicle) trucks to deliver chilled and frozen foods to convenience stores from the beginning of August.

The CO2 emissions of BEV trucks (per vehicle/year) are expected to be reduced by 13% compared to conventional diesel vehicles, and a dedicated battery charger was installed at the Shinko Office (Shinko, Mihama-ku, Chiba-shi, Chiba) for the introduction.

The model is the "ELF EV" of Isuzu Motors Ltd. (CEO: Shinsuke Minami, Head Office: Yokohama, Kanagawa). This is the company's first commercial BEV vehicle with a mass-produced battery.

Drivers who have ridden the car have commented "the sound is quiet" and "the car starts off smoothly".
