EXPO 2025 - "MUSASHI of the World" Solo Exhibition Collaboration Project -

minalab. Selected as Saitama Representative for the MUSASHI imes 47 Prefectures Collaborative Art Project

Minaminihon Total Logistics Service Inc. (Head Office: Nakano-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director and President: Keiichiro Ozono; hereinafter, "our company"), which transports chilled and frozen foods, and DENBA DISS Inc. (Head Office: Toda City, Saitama Prefecture; Representative Director and President: Keiichiro Ozono; hereinafter, "DENBA DISS"), jointly operate the Type B continuous employment support office "minalab.", which was selected as the representative of Saitama Prefecture for the collaborative project "MUSASHI \times 47 Prefectures Collaborative Art Project," a collaboration held as part of the "MUSASHI of the World" solo exhibition at the Osaka-Kansai Expo, and exhibited its work in the project exhibition.

This participation in the special exhibition was made possible by an offer from the Expo MUSASHI Solo Exhibition Secretariat to *minalab.*, a Type B continuous employment support office, requesting participation in a collaboration project with "MUSASHI of the World," a paraartist.

The MUSASHI \times 47 Prefectures Collaborative Art Project was held over two days, July 9 and 10, at the Expo 2025 Osaka-Kansai Gallery WEST. The total number of visitors over the two days reached approximately 20,000, reflecting MUSASHI's popularity and the high level of interest in this special exhibition.

On the day of the event, instead of a physical exhibition of the artwork, a method was used in which visitors scanned a QR code to view the work online. This piece was created by a minalab. user who enjoys graphic art as a hobby. With support from the facility staff, the work was somehow completed in time for the opening of the special exhibition.

minalab. is a Type B continuous employment support office that, through hydroponics, connects agriculture and welfare, provides learning of the knowledge necessary for employment, conducts training to improve abilities, and aims for general employment together. Recently, in addition to "hydroponic cultivation and management" and "vegetable sales," it has been expanding into various initiatives such as online sales of the "Veg Bottle" (a hydroponics starter kit). Employment training is conducted for each task in accordance with the characteristics of the users.

At minalab., we will continue to actively engage in new businesses, enrich our operations, and work on employment support and skill development that match the abilities and characteristics of each user, aiming together for general employment.
