- Launch of a Large-Scale Logistics Hub in the Bay Area as a Key to

Minaminihon Total Logistics Service Inc. (Head Office: Nakano-ku, Tokyo; CEO: Keiichiro Ozono; hereinafter referred to as “our company”), a company that transports chilled and frozen foods, is pleased to announce that the Ichikawa Center (Ichikawa City, Chiba Prefecture) began operations on October 1.

The Ichikawa Center is in a prime location, approximately 1.4 km from the Chidori-cho IC on the Metropolitan Expressway Bayshore Route and about 15 km from central Tokyo, providing easy access to the heart of the city. It also offers excellent access to major ports and airports, and is a rare area where bonded warehouse registration and animal quarantine inspections can be conducted. This makes it a strategic hub

that will significantly enhance our future business, particularly our global operations.

In addition to being a multi-functional facility that combines a port-type bonded warehouse with an inland frozen and refrigerated warehouse, the Ichikawa Center will leverage our logistics network system (JFN: Japan Frozen & Chilled Network) to provide a one-stop solution service that enables delivery of imported goods from the port to wholesale, retail, and distribution centers nationwide.

Our company will continue to build a system capable of providing optimal solutions to meet the growing demand for frozen and refrigerated logistics in the future.
